I have been shooting Competitive Archery for over 25 years. Starting out as a youth I shot mostly Indoors in the Winter, and High School Sports in the Summer. I was brought up under the teachings of Scott Schultz, President of Scent Loc, and Mike Meyers, Head of the Archery Department at Kenzies. After leaving PA, I joined the Military and hunted in South Dakota, Colorado, Alaska and Idaho. Shooting in Alaska I had more time to get into Competitive Archery, under the guidance of the North West NFAA Director John Sheets, and my good friend Tim Gillingham. After leaving the military, I got a job at CCI Spear in Lewiston, Idaho. At that time I began shooting more 3D Competitions, which brought me into contact with Dave Powers and the Clearwater Family. After the buy out of Clearwater Archery to Burley Hall with Storm Archery, I moved east.

I have been Instructing Archery for over 10 years. I helped and Volunteered with the JOAD Program in Alaska. In Idaho I worked with Ryan Greene, Randy Meeks and many others. In Pennsylvania I taught Donny Frysinger, who has been in many of the top 10 of the IBO for the past 3 years, and last year he helped win the IBO AHC Team Shoot. In Florida I have taught Adam Jirovsky, who has accomplished State and National ASA's, IBO Southern Triple Crown, and NFAA State Records. I have also taught Cheri Houle-Klawitter, who has accomplished 5 State Titles 3 State Records, 3 Sectional Titles and 1 Sectional Record and 6 Top 10 finishes and 3 Top 5s at the National ASA and State ASA Shooter of the Year. I have also helped many shooters get on with National Shooting Programs.

At the Local level, I trouble shoot and fix all makes and models of bows. I have designed a Unique way of building custom bow strings, and have eliminated serving separation.

Some of my personal accomplishments are:

- In Alaska, I accomplished Indoors, Field and 3D State Titles, and also the Alaska Bow Hunters Championship.
- I traveled all over Idaho, Montana and Washington for 3D shoots. I always Placed in the Top 5.
- In Pennsylvania, I won the IBO, ASA and PSAA State Shoots.
- I also shot the IBO National Triple Crown 1, 2 and 3<sup>rd</sup> Legs, and IBO Worlds, where I finished 5<sup>th</sup>.

- I took a little 33 inch hunting bow and won a ten week Indoor League, against target bows, and defeated the 2 time State Champion John Wyble.
- In 2007 when I moved to Florida, I began competing again, having not picked up the bow in 5 years, due to school.
- I shot the IBO Southern Triple Crown 1, 2 and 3<sup>rd</sup> Legs and Worlds. Placing 9<sup>th</sup> overall.
- In 2008, IBO Southern Triple Crown 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Leg. Placing 3<sup>rd</sup> Overall.
- I shot NFAA State Field and FITA Field and Placed 1<sup>st</sup> and in the State 600 I placed 3<sup>rd</sup>
- I shot the ASA State coming in 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- In 2009, I began with: 1<sup>st</sup> on the State UnMarked 3D with a 624 the second place scoring 591.
- In our Local Indoor League, 10 Week average was 300 with a 56x.
- IBO Southern Triple Crown 1<sup>st</sup> Leg and Placed 1<sup>st</sup>.
- NFAA State and Sectional Indoor, I placed 1<sup>st</sup> and set 2 State Records, and missed the Sectional Record by 1 X.
- IBO Southern Triple Crown 2<sup>nd</sup> Leg and Placed 5<sup>th</sup>
- NFAA State International and Placed 3<sup>rd</sup>
- NFAA State and Sectional Field- Hunter- Animal, I placed 1<sup>st</sup> in the State and 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Sectional
- NFAA State and Sectional 3D, Placing 4<sup>th</sup> in the Sectional.
- IFAA 2009 NAFAC, I tied for 1<sup>st</sup> Place but took 2<sup>nd</sup> due to 2 X's. I shot the highest score in Men's Open Freestyle for the Hunter Round
- ASA State Qualifier, Jan 10, 2010 in Homestead, FL. I had the highest score of the tournament.
- ASA Nationals: attended 5, 1 Top 10. Did very well on all the SIMS
- ASA State Qualifiers: Attended 4, three 1<sup>st</sup> Place and a 3<sup>rd</sup> Place.
- ASA State 1<sup>st</sup> for Shooter of the Year.
- State ASA Championship 1<sup>st</sup> Place
- FL State and Sectional Field: 3<sup>rd</sup> in State and 2<sup>nd</sup> in Sectionals
- 1st Annual Legends Shoot: 1<sup>st</sup> Place. Awesome shoot down 2-14s, 2-12s and a 10
- Local Traveling 3D: Attended 5 of 6, 4- 1<sup>st</sup> Place and a 3<sup>rd</sup> , finishing 2<sup>nd</sup>. Won the Steel Buck at 84yds for \$500
- Reinhart 100 Tampa, Won the Steel Buck at 90yds for a dozen Gold Tip Arrows
